- FIND YOUR CHAIR WITH YOUR NAME ON IT. This will be your seat in Millennium Place for the ceremony. How you entered today is how you will enter at Millennium Place.
- Please pay attention if you are the beginning of a line or the end of a row.



Expectations from Administration

 - There will be several checkpoints in the line-up to crossing the stage.



Timeline: Doors open at 12:00pm



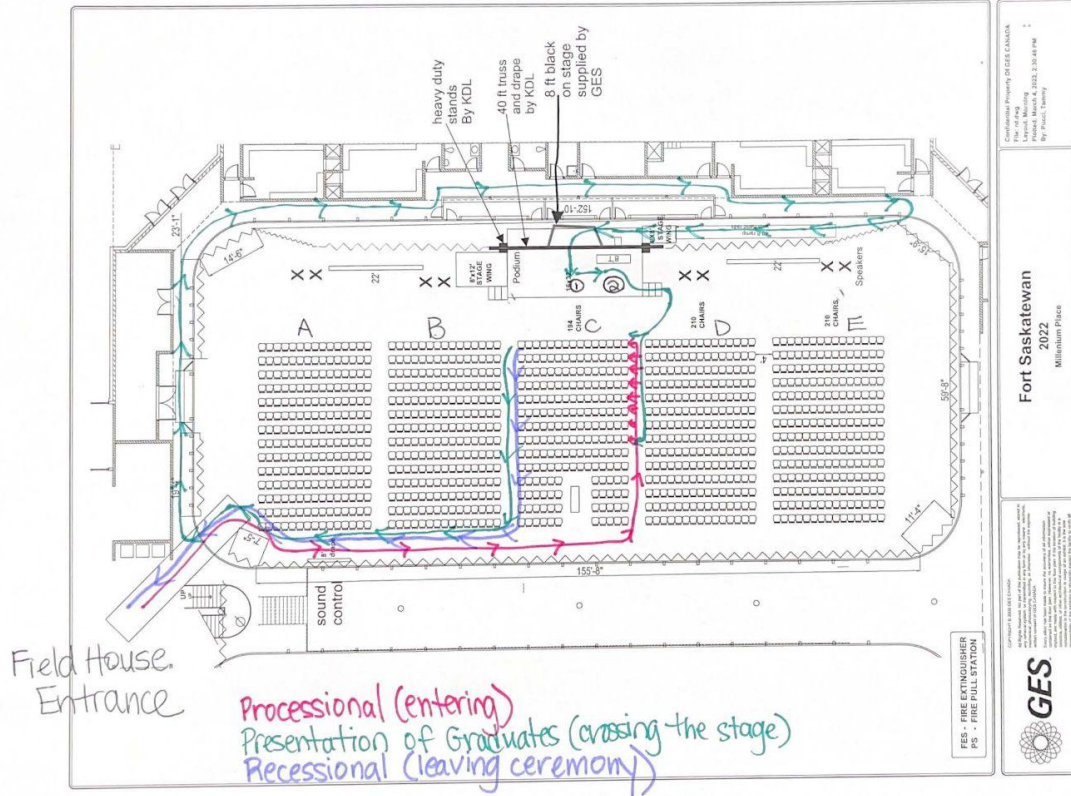
1. Doors open and grad gown pick up begins at 12:00pm
2. You must be ready and in your gown **no later than 12:30**
3. Lines get sorted (A-Z). Remember your staff leader.
4. Doors open at 12:00, families sit down and grads stay behind with staff leaders.
5. Processional @ 1:00pm ("Pomp and Circumstance)
6. If you are late, we are still starting at 1:00pm
7. File in Alphabetical order, performers in first
8. Ceremony starts after the processional



Timeline continued

8. Crossing of the Stage (A-L), return to seats
9. Crossing of the Stage (M-Z), return to seats
10. Ceremony Finishes and throw the hat
11. Recessional, walk out in alphabetical order
12. Take a flower, give to someone you want to thank
13. Take a picture or two, then **RETURN YOUR GRAD GOWN**
14. Return by 7:15 to lineup for the Grand March

Crossing the stage





A-L Line-up: Peddle & Sawatzky



- The only changes here are the performers get into the alphabetical order.
- Tassel goes on your **RIGHT** before you cross the stage!

Crossing the stage: Remember your place

- We are now going to practice crossing the stage. Same order as what you're sitting in except performers join in. Only get up when Gulp/Lexus announce your section.
- Do not exit your row until the previous row has cleared. People on the ends, pay attention!
- “We will ask the graduates A-L to get up and get ready to cross the stage”



M-Z Line Up: Adams & Cole



- The only changes here are the performers get into the alphabetical order.
 - Tassel goes on your **RIGHT** before you cross the stage!

Crossing the stage: Green means go!



- Mr. Edwards or Ms. Orchard will say your name
- You start walking. They read your future plans
- You will go out on the stage and find the “1”.
- Smile!!!
- Ms. Poss will tell you when to stop and go
- Shake hands, then Starko will move the tassel from right to left at “2”, Ms. Bennet will give you your certificate.
- Leave Stage and go back to your seat.
- “We are now ready for graduates M-Z”



Line Up: Remember your place!



- Please remember the person who goes in front of you and the person who is behind you. Pay attention if you are the end of a row.
- If you are a performer, you will have to know where you are in the order so you can leave your performance seat and get in line for walking the stage.



Throwing the Hat!



- Once the ceremony is coming to an end, Mr. Starko will come to the podium and tell you to throw your hat. Give it a toss!!!
- Once the hats are thrown, you can retrieve a hat and then we will leave in the same line we walked in on.



Future Plans: Final Edits



- Please take a look over your future plans. This will be read as you cross the stage.
- If you have any edits, please make sure you hand them in to Ms. Peddle **before** you grab your lunch.
- If you have no edits you still need to hand them in.

- If you have a name that is difficult for people to pronounce, please go see Mr. Edwards and Mrs. Orchard to phonetically sound/spell it out. We want to get it right!
